On March 5, 2007, the Subcommittee on National Security and Foreign Affairs held a hearing to investigate allegations of unacceptable care and living conditions of wounded soldiers at the Walter Reed Army Medical Center in Washington, DC. This hearing followed up on *The Washington Post's* coverage of conditions at Walter Reed, and was the first part in an ongoing series of hearings on this issue.
