

"Oversight of U.S.-Pakistan Relations: From Ad Hoc and Transactional to Strategic and Enduring"

On September 24, 2008, the Subcommittee on National Security and Foreign Affairs continued its oversight of U.S.-Pakistan relations. The hearing discussed the environment within Pakistan and the challenges that this environment places on U.S. efforts; the internal security and counterterrorism challenges, as well as potential opportunities for improvement; the regional context for Pakistan, with a focus on Afghanistan; and, most important, ideas and proposals for the future of U.S.-Pakistan relations and U.S. assistance.
