

“One Year after Walter Reed: An Independent Assessment of the Care, Support, and Disability Evaluation for Wounded Soldiers ”

On February 27, 2008, the Subcommittee on National Security and Foreign Affairs held its fourth oversight hearing to examine the executive branch's actions and plans to reform the health care system for wounded soldiers. The hearing continued the Subcommittee's sustained oversight to ensure that problems identified are corrected and that sound recommendations made by the variety of commissions are actually implemented, and that all of these corrective measures are undertaken with a sense of urgency.
