On June 24, 2008, the Subcommittee on National Security and Foreign Affairs conducted an oversight hearing into U.S. Coalition Support Funds to Pakistan. The Coalition Support Funds (CSF) program was created after 9/11 to reimburse coalition partners for their logistical and combat support of U.S. military operations in the global war on terror.
