

“U.S. Aid to Pakistan: Planning and Accountability”

On Wednesday, December 9, 2009, the Subcommittee on National Security and Foreign Affairs continued its extensive oversight of U.S. efforts in Pakistan by conducting a hearing designed to examine U.S. economic and development assistance programs including the Enhanced Partnership with Pakistan Act, informally known as the Kerry-Lugar-Berman bill that was signed by President Obama on October 15, 2009.
