

Washington, DC (July 20, 2012) – On Wednesday, July 25, 2012, Rep. Elijah E. Cummings, Ranking Member of the House Committee, will testify before the Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation about a joint report on “gray market” drug companies as part of a bicameral investigation led by Cummings, Senator Rockefeller, Chairman of the Senate Commerce Committee, and Senator Harkin, Chairman of the Senate Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions Committee.

Cummings launched the [investigation](#) nearly a year ago after receiving a letter from University of Maryland women’s basketball coach Brenda Frese, who was having difficulty obtaining medication on the FDA’s shortage list to treat her son’s leukemia.
