

Beginning at 2:00 p.m., the Committee will markup H.R. 1124, the DC Tuition Assistance Grant program, and an amendment to the National Capital Transportation Act of 1969. Several commemorative and postal naming bills will also be considered, as well as the oversight plans of the 110th Congress.

**H.R. 1124** reauthorizes funding for the District of Columbia Tuition Assistance Grant (DC TAG) program, which has helped promote higher education for high school graduates in the District of Columbia.

**The National Capital Transportation Amendments Act of 2007** authorizes funding that will allow WMATA to make necessary station and tunnel repairs as well as improvements such as adding new rail cars and buses to ease congestion.
