**September 13, 2011 -- Dems look to give Postal Service 90-day extension on retiree payment**

House Democrats on Monday proposed legislation that would add 90 days to an end-of-September deadline by which the U.S. Postal Service must make a \$5.5 billion payment to a retiree health benefits fund.

Rep. Elijah Cummings (D-Md.), the ranking member of the House Oversight and Government Reform Committee, and other Democrats said the extension is needed to give Congress more time to find ways to make sure the USPS stays "profitable and competitive in the 21st century economy."
